This summer and going forward:

- Monday at Jingan:
 - We will have field 1 for summer league games and field 2 for regular pickup from 8-10pm. Pickup fees are still 50rmb for workers and 40 for students. Please pay in cash, or Alipay to the arranged SUPA collector on Monday night (we would prefer to not use Wechat pay).

- Weekends at SCSC:
 - Previously we have only had pickup at SCSC. This summer, and going forward, we will have more invite only club team practices. This means NOT every Saturday will have pickup. Stay tuned in the SUPA chat for details.

- Shanghai High School Hat Tourney
 - SUPA is helping to support the first one day Shanghai High School Hat Tourney July 1st. High Schoolers are jonesin' for some more ultimate opportunities—stay tuned for more youth competition going forward!

- Shanghai Fall Hat Tourney
 - This year we'll have our annual fall 1 day hat tournament on Saturday September 2nd. Stay tuned for details.

- Fall League:
 - As always, Fall League registration will begin in early August to start games in the beginning of September. Stay tuned in the SUPA account for details.

- AOUGCC:
 - Manila will be hosting the Asia Oceanic Ultimate and Guts Club Championships (AOUGCC) this August 17th-20th. China is sending 4 teams (Women's, Mixed and two Men's teams) with many players from Shanghai representing all divisions.

 - Currently SUPA is not a formal entity and is just a community of players who like to play Frisbee. Like pickup-basketball and the soccer leagues in Shanghai, SUPA does not offer insurance and it's up to the players and fans to play responsibly.

This past spring:

- Spring League:
 - Perhaps it was the prospect of nice weather, perhaps it was Jingan's beautiful green AstroTurf, or maybe the game is just too much fun, but a record number of players signed up for Spring league. - Spring League Clinic:

 - This March Shanghai hosted the first full weekend Open and Women's club team tournament. It was a great weekend with 12 Open teams and 8 women's teams showing up—including 7 teams from Shanghai. Spring single gender play is here to stay!

- Shanghai Open Youth Tournament:
 - Another successful SH Youth Tournament. We had 23 teams representing over 25 middle and high schools from Beijing, Hangzhou, Shanghai and Hong Kong. HK CIS repeated its 3-peat—let's see if we can bring the crown to Shanghai next year!

- Shanghai Open
 - This June SUPA hosted the 19th annual Shanghai Open. This was the largest and most competitive tournament in China with 24 teams—7 of which came from Shanghai!
